Guidelines for calculation of Self-assessed API score for Joint Authors

1. **API score of Category III:** The scores as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based on Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in AICTE Regulations 2012. (F. No. 37-3/Legal/AICTE/2012 , dated 8th November,2012)
2. Impact factor to be determined as per Thomson Reuters list

The Research Score for papers with joint authors would be calculated as follows:

Joint Publication:

- (a) **Two authors:** 60% of total value of publication for each author.
- (b) **More than two authors:** 60% of total value of publication for the First/Principal/Corresponding author and 40% of total value of publication for each of the joint authors.

Joint Projects:

Principal Investigator and Co-investigator would get 50% each

Note:

- Paper presented if part of edited book or proceeding then it can be claimed only once.
- For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 60% of the total score for Supervisor and Cosupervisor.
