Instructions and Guidelines:

1. **Download and install** the Microsoft Teams app on the laptop/ device to be used for the test.
2. Ensure the **laptop/device is fully charged** and a **stable internet connection** is available.
3. Students should join ETS online using **MS Teams credentials (link will be shared only through domain email)** at **least 10 minutes** before the start of the talk. For any technical issues, contact the ETS coordinator immediately.
4. Use MS Teams login credentials **twice**:
 - First, to access the **ETS session**, and
 - Again, to access the **ETS test link**.
5. Enter the **full roll number accurately** when logging in. Incomplete or incorrect roll numbers will not be considered for **attendance or test**. Use **only the domain email**.
6. Students must maintain a **100-page ETS NOTEBOOK** to record learnings from each session.
7. Use the **Q&A feature** in Microsoft Teams for all interactions and queries during the session. **Do not use the chat function**, as it will be disabled.
8. Each expert talk is followed by a **10-minute online quiz/test** consisting of **10 multiple-choice or fill-in-the-blank questions** based on the session content.
9. The test will be conducted using the Microsoft Teams **Town Hall feature**. **Note:** the chat function will be **disabled** during the Town Hall session.
10. The test link will be provided through the **Q&A feature immediately at the end of the session**.

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
