#### 1. Introduction

### 2. Activities Conducted

During the Anti-Ragging Awareness Mahautsav, a variety of competitions and awareness activities were organized to ensure active student participation.

## 2.1 Essay Writing Competition

- Theme options included: "Eradicating Ragging: Building a Culture of Respect and Dignity", "Ragging: A Crime Against Humanity", and "My Role in Preventing Ragging on Campus."
- 16 **students** registered via Google Form and participated.
- The essays highlighted the psychological, emotional, and social consequences of ragging, while also suggesting preventive measures.

## 2.2 Stage Performances (Drama/Skit/Dance)

- 3teams showcased **short plays and skits** on themes such as "Breaking the Cycle of Ragging" and "Unity and Respect: A Ragging-Free Campus."
- Performances were conducted in the Auditorium in English, Hindi, and Telugu.
- Students effectively portrayed the harmful impact of ragging and emphasized empathy, respect, and peer support.
