(This email ID shall be used by any student, faculty, or staff member of KITSW to report concerns, share information, or seek support related to drug abuse prevention and redressal.

1. Our campus is a non-smoking campus. Possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages/ toxic materials and the presence of students on the campus under the influence of alcoholic/toxic materials is a serious offence. Smoking in and around the institute is strictly prohibited. Any student found smoking will be subject to disciplinary action. Possession or consumption of alcohol, narcotics, or weapons is strictly prohibited.
2. The Anti-Drug Committee shall conduct awareness programmes such as workshops, seminars, orientation sessions, and counseling initiatives to educate students about the ill effects of drugs. It shall also encourage peer monitoring and reporting of any suspected cases to the authorities.
3. If anyone is found, reasonably believed to be indulging in consumption or possession or sale or purchase of Narcotic and Psychotropic drugs, the committee should inform the police.
4. Any instance of possession or use of narcotic/psychotropic substances shall be reported immediately to the police helpline (Tel: 8712671111, Email: tsnabhohyd@tspolice.gov.in / helpline@kitsw.ac.in). All such reports will be treated as strictly confidential.
5. The term of office of the members shall be for a period of one year.
6. It shall be the overall responsibility, to put in place other systems and checks to eradicate the menace of Narcotic drugs from in and around the premises.
